# **Treasurers Report, Melinda Surmani:**

- Part of the treasures report was missing from the packet. The revised version will be on the website.
- There is a large deposit in the bank account for the sidewalk project grant.
  - A lot of the older neighborhoods are missing sections of sidewalks causing potential safety concerns. We applied for a grant for just under \$7500 for a sidewalk in the Historic Sierra Vista NA.
  - Those funds are currently in our bank account but will be going back to the city because they will be doing the work.
  - o We will be applying for more grants in the future.

# **Spring Clean-up Committee Report, Jim Kidd:**

- In the agenda packet there was a recap of the spring clean-up.
  - o 1374 vehicles came
  - o 71 bins of trash were taken
  - o 123 tons of junk was dumped
- Thanks to clean-up committee for the great job.
- It is in the budget for next year.
- By January 1st we need to decide if there are new or different sites needed.
