Minutes: The minutes of the June 15, 2023 meeting were accepted as amended and placed on file.

Roseville Police Update, Lt. Ciampa:

- Planning for August 1st NNO.

 - There are 20 neighborhoods registered that PD will make appearances at.
- There was an event at Sierra Gardens Elementary school recently where kids could see the police vehicles.
- Today was the closing event for RPLA summer camps with a lot of activities for the kids.
- Questions:
 - There has been some change in the department. Some NA's are not having officers attend meetings. Is there a new contact person?
 - No, there should be no change. Unless they are on a call, officers should be there. Contact Officer Ciampa if needed.
 - Maidu held a pancake event that the police were supposed to help at and no officers showed up.
 - Apologies, they were short staffed because a lot of officers were on vacation. They will work on improving communication.

Roseville Fire Department Update, Jaime Garrett:

- Blaze, a K9 support animal has joined the department. He will be part of the care support team and he will be out in the community at events.
- It's hot, you can find places to cool down on the city's website, including the downtown library with extended hours.
- Luckily, wildfire season is off to a slow start. There have been some fires around the state so be aware if you are traveling and know how to evacuate.

 - It was a busy day. Resources got stretched thin. There was a large grass fire on the west side of town.

Roseville City Update, Brian Jacobson:

- State of the City address will be at 9:00 am on August 25th in the Westfield Galleria Center Court. Get free tickets ahead of time.
- My Roseville App is getting close to a public release-
 - Brian shared what the app looks like and how to use it. It will be used to help residents find resources, report issue, make requests.
- It will be available in about a month in the app store. If you are interested in helping the city test the app, please email Kevin.

Treasurers Report, Melinda Surmani:

- Part of the treasures report was missing from the packet. The revised version will be on the website.
- There is a large deposit in the bank account for the sidewalk project grant.
 - A lot of the older neighborhoods are missing sections of sidewalks causing potential safety concerns. We applied for a grant for just under \$7500 for a sidewalk in the Historic Sierra Vista NA.
 - Those funds are currently in our bank account but will be going back to the city because they will be doing the work.
 - We will be applying for more grants in the future.

Spring Clean-up Committee Report, Jim Kidd:

- In the agenda packet there was a recap of the spring clean-up.
 - 1374 vehicles came
 - 71 bins of trash were taken
 - 123 tons of junk was dumped
- Thanks to clean-up committee for the great job.
- It is in the budget for next year.
- By January 1st we need to decide if there are new or different sites needed.
- Questions/Comments:
 - Suggestions- at Buljan have cars go in a different direction to minimize back-up on the main roads.
 - In the past the city has had a problem with traffic moving through the park when the play structure is, Jim will ask again.
 - People don't know we are volunteers, is there a way to communicate that?
 - You can go to 1603 American Logo wear to have the RCONA logo put on an item of clothing.
 - Lanyards are being made that volunteers will be able to wear.
