Scholarship Details:

Two to ten scholarships (however the school system allows the input) @ a minimum of \$300 each for students who qualify as follows:

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- General Application.
- Transcript with GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Community Service - We require confirmation of community volunteer service at RCONA neighborhood events (1 or more) in order of preference: 1) RCONA event; 2) Neighborhood Association level event or service. This information can be noted in the Community Activity Section of the "General Application."
- Please identify in your Essay the Neighborhood Association with which you are associated. This can be found in <https://rcona.org/> under My Neighborhood.
- Recommendation letter from a Teacher OR High School Counselor.
- Special Essay of 250-500 words answering the following question:  
"How has volunteering for RCONA or a Neighborhood Association event(s) and in your community helped shape who you are today?"
